







The following chart indicates the Training and Consultation Initiatives identified as needs across the county by those that participated in this assessment survey.


The following chart defines the support needs of School Administrators.




The following chart defines the Behavioral Services needs across the county based on program needs by those that participated in this assessment survey.

The following are the Behavioral Supports that the respondents suggested in the survey.

Instruction for students on how they can interact with students who require varying degrees of accommodations. I think we sometimes overlook the students in the classroom who may not understand why another student behaves differently or has accommodations that they do not receive.

Social-Emotional mitigation regarding bullying, trauma, efforts to create a more safe learning environment regardless of outside stimuli or factors.

FBAs completed by outside personnel when students are repeatedly identified as having behaviors that are beyond the scope of "typical" behaviors that the regular education teachers have been trained and equipped to deal with.

The following are the Expanded Supports that the respondents suggested in the survey.

I would like to see all paraprofessionals trained and certified for behaviors.

Behavioral and mental health support services for our students and our teachers and staff.

Consistent, High-Quality Professional Development – Ongoing, research-based training in structured literacy that isn't just a one-time workshop but includes follow-up coaching and collaboration time.

Stronger MTSS/RTI Frameworks â€" More clarity, consistency, and practical tools for tracking student progress and implementing effective interventions before students fall too far behind.

Technology Tools for Structured Literacy â€" More access to digital platforms that align with research-based literacy instruction, providing engaging, individualized practice for students.
